

THE WAY OF SALVATION

Question: What is Salvation?

Answer: Deliverance from sin.

Question: What constitutes Salvation?

Answer: Grace. {Ephesians 2:8}, "For by grace are ye saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is a gift of God."

Question: Who are the objects of Salvation?

Answer: Sinners are the objects Salvation.

Question: Through what medium does Salvation come to the sinner?

Answer: Through the mediatorial offices of the Son of God.

Question: Who is the Son of God?

Answer: Jesus Christ! {Matthew 3:17}, "And lo a voice from heaven saying, this is my beloved Son in whom I am well pleased."

Question: What are the ⁴V'ediatorial Offices' of the Son of God?

Answer: Prophet, Priest and King.

Question: What is a Prophet?

Answer: One who predicts future facts. (That he is one who speaks for God.)

Question: Is Christ a Prophet?

Answer: Yes. {Matthew 20:18-19}, "Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of Man shall be betrayed unto the chief priest and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn Him to death, and shall deliver Him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify Him, and the third day, He shall rise again."

Question: What is a Priest?

Answer: One who offers sacrifices.

Question: Did Christ offer sacrifices.

Answer: He sacrificed himself. {1s^t Corinthians 5:7}, "Purge out, therefore, the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ, our Passover is sacrificed for us."

Question: What is a King?

Answer: One who rules.

Question: How do you know Jesus was King?
Answer: {Acts 17:7}, "Whom Jason had received; and these all do contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying, there is another King, one Jesus."

Question: What was necessary for Christ to do in order to secure our Salvation?
Answer: To die and make an atonement.

Question: What do you mean by 'Atonement'?
Answer: Satisfaction rendered to the law for some injury, being made 'one with God'

Question: For what did Christ make this atonement?
Answer: For our sins. (Isaiah 53:5), "But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon Him, and with His stripes we are healed."

Question: To whom did He make this atonement?
Answer: To God.

Question: What part did the sinner receive?
Answer: The benefits.

Question: Where is Christ now?
Answer: He is enthroned in heaven. (Hebrews 8:1), "Now of the things which we have spoken, this is the sum; we have such a high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the majesty in the heavens."

Question: Can salvation come through any other than Jesus?
Answer: No. (Acts 4:12), "Neither is there salvation in any other; for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved."
